

## Lincoln Attraction Updates

- **Adventure Golf Center** – OPEN. Hours are 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Friday and 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. on Sundays. Call 402-421-2254 with questions.
- **American Historical Society of Germans from Russia** – The museum, bookstore and research library will RE-OPEN to the public on Tuesday, May 26. NOTE: The following temporary restrictions will be in place:
  - All tours, visits and in-person research requests must be scheduled by appointment only.
  - No more than five people allowed in a specific facility/museum space at a time.
  - Maximum of 10 individuals spaced throughout the building, staff not included.
  - We ask that all visitors wear masks when visiting the facility.
  - A limited number of masks and hand sanitizer will be available.
  - In-person research library requests are permitted by appointment on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
